Greeter Group Guidelines

Ensuring the Safety and Enjoyment of all Guests is your mission.

- 1. <u>All Volunteers</u> should arrive **20 minutes** before the shift to be in place for the shift opening. Enter the West side door of the Cascade Pavilion marked CSBL Volunteers.
- 2. <u>Adult Volunteers age 18 or over must complete the **CSBL Injury Release and Safety Acknowledgements** each year before participating. Click <u>here</u> to complete the acknowledgements.</u>
- 3. <u>Parents/Guardians of Teen Volunteers age 13-17</u> must complete a **Parent/Guardian Minor Release** before a teen participates. Click <u>here</u> to complete the form then save and email to <u>CSBLGreeters@gmail.com</u> or print and bring a copy to the event.
- 4. NEW! Group Leaders solicit volunteers to operate the event and email a list of volunteers who completed the Injury Release and Safety Acknowledgement and the volunteers with minors who completed a Parent/Guardian Minor Release form. Email the list to CSBLGreeters@gmail.com stating your *Greeter Date & Shift* no less than 4 days before your Greeter Date.
- 5. <u>Everyone</u> checks in with the Head Greeter and receives a CSBL lanyard, flashlight, instructions, and station assignment.
- 6. <u>Greeter Guidelines:</u>
 - Stay near your assigned station until a relief greeter or Head Greeter relieves you-unless there is an emergency
 - Avoid use of phones and texting unless there is an emergency
 - ➤ Do not touch visitors (especially children) or assist them in the restroom. Ask for assistance from a parent or accompanying adult
- 7. Guest Safety--Tactfully request children and adults to avoid:
 - touching any displays or trains
 - running through aisles
 - going inside scenes—stay in front of scene fences
- 8. <u>A "super" greeter will:</u>
 - ➤ Identify the Head Greeter
 - Locate and give directions to restrooms and emergency exits
 - Locate and be able to use fire extinguisher
 - ★ Marked "Extinguisher" just inside fences
 - ★ PASS: pull, aim, squeeze, sweep side to side at base of fire 6 feet back
 - Locate the First Aid Kits
 - Use flashlights and lead people out of building in case of emergency
 - > Report any scene that needs repair to the Head Greeter
 - Pick up any trash in aisles
 - > Return lanyard & flashlight before leaving
